RE: School Breakfast/Lunch Program

Dear PENNCREST Families:

We understand these are difficult and unprecedented times for you and our residents. We seek to find sensible balance while following federal and state mandates and guidance. The US Department of Agriculture has granted a waiver for Pennsylvania School Districts to provide meals to students currently on the free lunch program.

The Board of School Directors has extended meals to any school-age child in the district regardless if they attend our schools or qualify for free/reduced breakfast or lunch. No child will be turned away.

Breakfast and lunch distribution will occur in a drive through style “brown bag” package. The meal package will contain breakfast and lunch servings for the upcoming days.

The student must be present and provide his/her address. PENNCREST student ID and school of attendance should be provided if applicable.

Meals will be distributed as follows until staffing becomes inadequate or food availability is compromised:

Wednesday, March, 18 from 4:00pm – 6:00pm (6 meals per student)

Monday, March, 23 from 4:00pm – 6:00pm (6 meals per student)

Wednesday, March 25 from 4:00pm – 6:00pm (4 meals per student)
