

Q/If	A/Then
If you are sick, ill, or unwell	Stay home until you feel better, do not come to school
If you have a temperature over 100.4	Stay home until you are fever free, without medication, for 72 hours
If you have multiple symptoms and suspect you may have had direct primary exposure (15 minutes of personal contact with a confirmed case) to COVID-19	Quarantine for 14 days <b>OR</b> have a negative test after 72 hours
If you were told by the PA DoH (or a representative) and informed that you have been contact traced as having been exposed	Follow PA DoH personnel guidance
If you have returned from a COVID-19 "hot spot"	Quarantine for 14 days <b>OR</b> have a negative test after 72 hours of returning
If you were within in close proximity to someone who was in close proximity to another person who tested positive for COVID-19	Limit unnecessary travel, take your temperature daily and monitor yourself for symptoms
When can you return to school after a confirmed positive COVID-19 test?	PA DoH or a medical professional will provide advice. A return to school/work medical note is required.
Where can I get tested for COVID-19?	Go to a PA DoH approved test center
